

INDUCTIVE TORAH STUDY FEAST OF TRUMPETS

Today we will continue our study with OBSERVING Cross References, related passages. We will repeat the OBSERVATION of all the related passages throughout the study using the whole counsel of the Word to determine the INTERPRETATION of the topic, book or passage we are studying. Then after INTERPRETATION phase is completed, we will APPLY what we have learned in our lives. Each day will build upon the previous and we will summarize what was OBSERVED in each. Group discussion allows you to share your insights with others who are participating in the study. Additional insight can be gleaned from the Observations of the group, so please share yours for discussion!

DAY 2

Always begin with PRAYER. Ask YHVH to open your eyes and heart to the Truth in His Word for the purpose of obedience to His Will and Ways.

Today we will look at more passages that tell us about “trumpets”. We will see WHY trumpets are sounded, WHEN they are sounded, WHERE they are sounded, etc. You will get good practice in OBSERVING today, there are a lot of passages so if you need to take more time than just one day, please feel free to do so.

1. Read in context (what is before and after) and list what you OBSERVE in each of the passages below about “trumpets”. Remember to ask the WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE, WHY and HOW questions about the text. Look for any repeated KEY WORDS/PHRASES throughout the study. Be sure to make a notation of WHEN and WHY the trumpets were/were to be blown and the reason for it, as well as if it is a prophetic and future blowing. Also, record any insights or connections to other passages that you see or that come to mind while you are OBSERVING the text.
