Fulfillment of Spring Appointed Times

| 30 YEARS | <p>It was 30 Years from Conception to the Beginning of Yeshua's Ministry. (Luke 3:23)</p> <p>Thirty is the number of dedication and the age the Levites were when they began Temple service.</p> | 40 WEEKS | <p>Gestation period of: 40 Weeks 285 Days 9 Mo & 11 Days</p> |
| 70 WEEKS | <p>His ministry was 70 weeks (Daniel 9:24). 1 week for each of the 70 nations (Genesis 10). Hinted at when Yeshua said we are to forgive our brother 70x7 (490 days) in Matthew 18:21-22.</p> | 40 WEEKS | |
| 3 DAYS & 3 NIGHTS | <p>The Messiah was to be in the grave 3 days and 3 nights (Sign of Jonah - Matthew 12:40) confirming that His death and burial occurred on a Wednesday before sundown.</p> | 40 WEEKS | |
| 40 DAYS | <p>The first day of Unleaven Bread is a High Sabbath (Leviticus 23:5-7), which is why He had to be in the grave before the Sabbath began. It wasn't the weekly Sabbath.</p> | 40 WEEKS | |
| 40 DAYS | <p>Yeshua ascended to the right hand of the Father 40 days after His resurrection (Acts 1:3-5).</p> | 50 DAYS | <p>Shavuot/Pentecost is 50 days from First Fruits (Leviticus 23:15-16). This is when the Spirit was poured out on the set-apart ones in Jerusalem (Acts 2:1-4).</p> |

Not Easter! Our Messiah rose on First Fruits (Leviticus 23:10-11) as He was referred to as the First Fruits of the resurrection by Paul (1 Corinthians 15:20).
